



## Seasonal Firefighter / EMT Position (non-benefited)

### Job Description:

Seasonal Firefighter / EMT position non-benefited. This position provides a range of services designed to protect the lives and property of the citizens and visitors of the Lake Billy Chinook / Grandview Or area from adverse effects of fires, sudden medical emergencies or exposure to dangerous conditions created by either man or nature.

Respond to the emergency scenes and non-emergency calls, applying necessary medical treatment to sick or injured persons, and transporting persons to intercept, LZ or a medical facility. Utilize thorough knowledge of appropriate EMT level skills and procedures obtained in EMT class and work in a confident and efficient manner.

Ability to perform duties in accordance with established fire operations and emergency medical SOGs and protocols. Demonstrate proficiency in all certification areas.

Provide Initial Attack on wildland fires as part of a type 4 or Type 6 engine or boat crew. Firefighters assigned to an engine crew operations, duties include operating the 6x6 or 4x4 wildland engines that pump and distribute water or foam, driving the wildland engines off-road, Operating 22 ' fire / rescue boat, communicating to facilitate suppression operations.

They also engage in other fire suppression work, including fireline construction, preparing fire breaks, burning out control lines, mopping up, felling small trees and cutting brush using a chainsaw. When not fighting fire, engine crews perform physical training and work projects basic facilities maintenance, fire prevention, and structural triage.

Each position is classed as an arduous fire position. As a condition of employment, you must pass a pre-employment medical examination. You will be required to achieve an arduous rating on the "Pack Test," which requires you to walk 3 miles with a 45 pound backpack in 45 minutes or less.

32 Hours per week. 8 hours per day. Plus Overtime.

Station resident housing is available as option.

Firefighter training provided weekly. CE hours and/or occupational OTJ.

### \*Qualifications:

Student or recent grad. Minimum 18YO, current Oregon Driver's license, Oregon Boaters Licence. Must be able to pass background test. Required: Wildland Firefighter NWCG / or DPSST certificate. Oregon EMT (or higher) license. Recommended: Firefighter 1, Apparatus Driver / Operator, Pumper Operator.
