

Recruitment for Summer Student Volunteer at: Three Rivers Fire District Lake Billy Chinook

General Information:



Three Rivers Fire District is seeking quality people who wish to become professional firefighters or paramedics to apply for our Summer Volunteer Program. This program provides the student with valuable benefits, but more importantly, the experience that cannot be attained in a classroom by working shoulder to shoulder with our professionals at emergency scenes in our district.

The Rural Fire Protection District is located on beautiful Lake Billy Chinook. Our district responds to a population of approximately 225 year round residents. A popular year-round destination for camping and water sports, this area swells to over 5000 visitors on any given weekend during the summer. Our Department responds to all calls

from the Cove Palisades State Park on the Deshutes arm of Lake Billy Chinook to Green Ridge and west to Perry South Campground which is an area of approximately 40 Sq Miles.

Summer Volunteer Benefits:

- \$1000 towards a term of college tuition, books, or fees
- Room provided rent free at Three Rivers Fire Station
- Training in structure and wildland firefighting, emergency medical, and fire prevention.
- Students will receive Wildland Training: S-130 and S-190, S-131 (Spring Wildland Academy Tuition)
- Training towards DPSST Wildland Firefighter Certification.
- · Water Rescue Training
- NFPA Firefighter I Fall Academy Tuition. S-215, S-290 training (2 seasons applicants)

Eligibility Requirements for the Summer Volunteer Program:

- Must be 18 years of age
- Non-smoker
- · Valid and insurable driver's license No felony record
- Valid Oregon Boaters Certification
- Maintain a 12 credit hour per term towards a degree in fire science.
 EMS, or registered nurse
- Must maintain a 2.5 GPA with a C grade minimum in every class Must be able to work 8 / 24 hour shifts per month Must reside in district for eight nights per month minimum
- EMT-B or Oregon First Responder Certification
